SAN FRANCISCO - 5 Days | Bay Area Student Tour

DAY 1

10:00 a.m. Board your flight to San Francisco

1:00 p.m. Arrive in San Francisco, where your Tour Director will meet you at the airport.

2:00 p.m. Board your washroom equipped, climate-controlled highway motor coach and depart for Fisherman's Wharf. En route, your Tour Director will get to know the students on a first name basis.

4:00 p.m. Expore Fisherman's Wharf. Discover the excitement of iconic Fisherman's Wharf, one of the busiest and most popular tourist attractions in the western United States.

DAY 2

7:30 a.m. Breakfast

9:30 a.m. Cruise to Alcatraz Island-round trip with audio tour.

Take a journey back in time with a cruise to the notorious Alcatraz Island, former home to infamous criminals like Al Capone, George "Machine Gun" Kelley, and Robert "The Birdman" Stroud. As you explore the National Park, you'll enjoy a captioned orientation video with historical footage, self-guided walks, exhibits, and Ranger-interpretive talks on topics like "Famous Escapes". The highlight of the tour is the award-winning audio tour of the prison Cell House, featuring actual interviews with former guards and inmates.

2:00 p.m. Walk across the Golden Gate Bridge. Discover one of the most iconic landmarks in the world. Opened to the public in 1937, this engineering marvel has stood the test of time. Stretching almost two miles across the Golden Gate—the narrow strait where San Francisco Bay meets the Pacific Ocean—the bridge connects the city of San Francisco to Marin County, California.

4:00 p.m. Visit the Golden Gate Fortune Cookie Factory. Get an inside look at how world-class cookies are made at the Golden Gate Fortune Cookie Factory, where up to 10,000 fortune cookies are made from scratch each day using a cast iron rotating griddle wheel and an assembly linestyle process.

4:45 p.m. Visit the City Lights Bookstore. Marvel at the magic of City Lights, one of the greatest independent bookstores in the United States.

10:00 a.m. Visit The Exploratorium. Discover a world of wonder at the museum of science, art, and human perception, featuring over 600 amazing interactive exhibits. You'll have the chance to dance with your own shadow, levitate objects, and even touch a simulated tornado.
